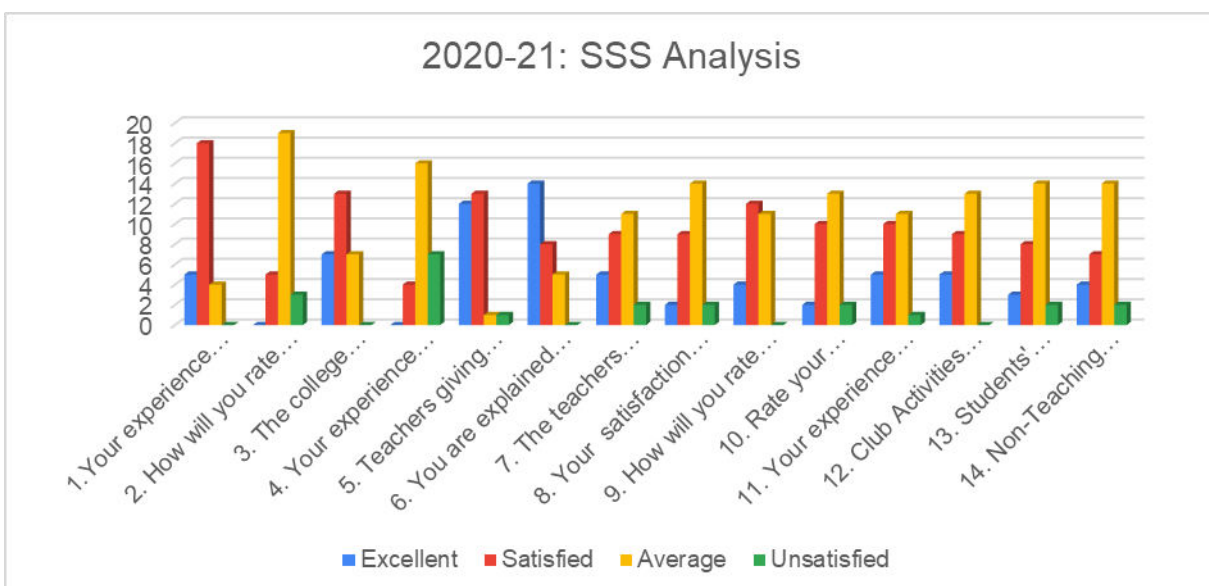


## Analysis of Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS)

Year: 2020-21

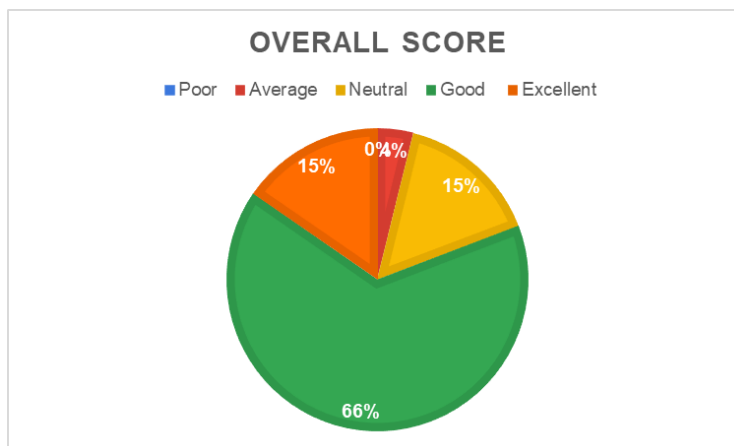
