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Introduction:

State College of Teacher Education formerly called Nagaland College of Education was established in 1975, under the initiative of North Eastern Hill University (NEHU) Shillong, and the Government of Nagaland, to cater to the qualitative improvement of teachers and school education in the state. It is among the first few teacher education institutions in the North-East to have been recognized by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE),

New Delhi. The College was affiliated to NEHU since its inception and only in 1995, it came under Nagaland University.

The College was assessed by NAAC in 2011 and had secured a 'B' Grade with a

CGPA of 2.52 on a 4 point scale. The M. Ed program was also introduced in the year 2014. It also offers a Certificate Course in Physical Education (CCPE). The Vision and Mission of the College include Impacting Social Uplift through Responsive, Relevant and Reflective Teacher Preparation and Preparing Reflective Humane Professionals as catalysts of Change, Proactively engaged in Redefining Process and Practice of Education.
