The college celebrated its Golden Jubilee on 7th November 2025 at the Capital Convention Centre, Kohima, under the theme “Empowering Teachers, Enriching Lives.” The event was a proud milestone for the institution, bringing together alumni, faculty, dignitaries, and students to reflect on fifty years of dedicated service in teacher education.

Dr. T Alemla Longkumer, Principal of Mokokchung College of Teachers Education, highlighted the evolving role of teachers as agents of change.
